**Category 1:** Interstate and subject to 49 C.F.R. part 391. (**Medical certificate and self-certification must be submitted**)

- All Class A, B, and C drivers who do NOT fall under any of the other categories.
- All Class A, B, and C drivers granted a federal vision or diabetes exemption; or SPE-limb impairment Skill Performance Evaluation.

**Category 2:** Interstate but operating exclusively in transportation or operations excepted under 49 C.F.R. part 390.3(f), 391.2, or 391.68 (**self-certification must be submitted**).

- Transportation performed by employees of the federal government, a state, or any political subdivision of a state.  
**(Note: The Motor Vehicle Commission requires ALL P (passenger) endorsement holders, including government workers, to submit a valid medical certificate in order to maintain the P endorsement on their CDL. N.J.A.C. 13:21-14.5(c)(6)**
- The transportation of human corpses or sick and injured persons.
- The operation of fire trucks and rescue vehicles while involved in emergency and related operations.
- Apiarian industries (Beekeepers).
- Farm vehicle drivers operating within a 150 mile radius of the farm.

**Category 3:** Intrastate and subject to state driver qualification requirements. (**Medical certificate and self-certification must be submitted**).

- All Class A, B, and C drivers who do NOT fall under any of the other categories.

**Category 4:** Intrastate, but operating exclusively in transportation or operations excepted from all or part of the state driver qualification requirements (**self-certification must be submitted**).

- Transportation performed by employees of the federal government, a state, or any political subdivision of a state.  
**(Note: The Motor Vehicle Commission requires ALL P (passenger) endorsement holders, including government workers, to submit a valid medical certificate in order to maintain the P endorsement on their CDL. N.J.A.C. 13:21-14.5(c)(6)**
- The transportation of human corpses or sick and injured persons.
- The operation of fire trucks and rescue vehicles while involved in emergency and related operations.
- Apiarian industries (Beekeepers).
- Farm vehicle drivers operating within a 150 mile radius of the farm.
