Law Enforcement Alert for Victims of Identity Theft

- The Minnesota Department of Public Safety recognizes that the misuse of your identity by someone else is a serious problem. Upon receipt of this completed form, an entry will be made on your driving record. This entry will alert law enforcement officers that someone else may be using your identity.
- This entry should prevent someone from using your name when involved with law enforcement.
- It is important for you to know that this entry may cause you inconvenience if you have contact with law enforcement personnel as they will specifically request your identification. For your own protection, it is recommended that you have your Minnesota driver's license or identification card with you at all times.
- ***This form will not prevent the use of your name in financial matters, such as establishing credit or other accounts.***
